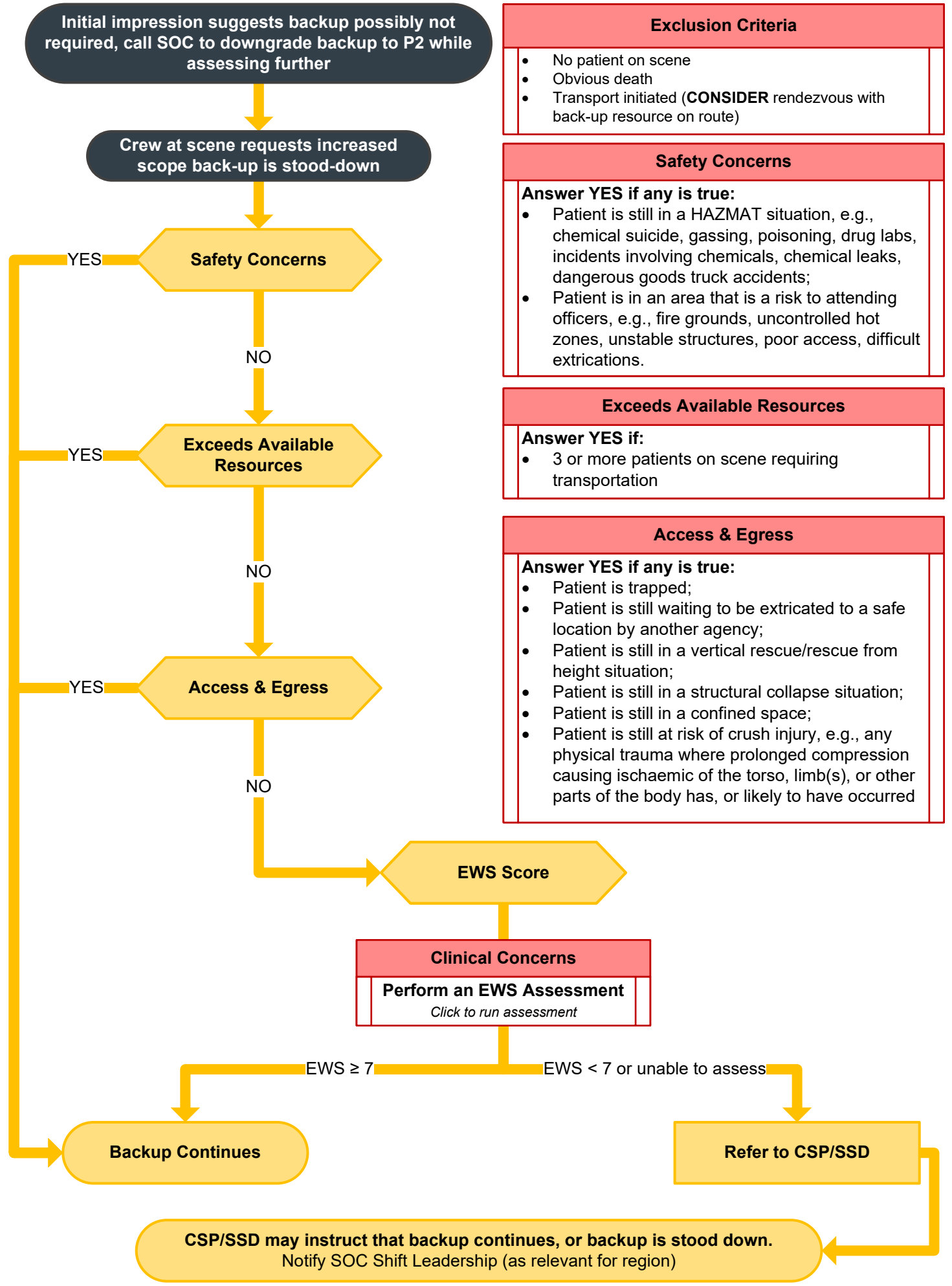




Standing down increased scope back-up



Exclusion Criteria	
•	No patient on scene
•	Obvious death
•	Transport initiated (CONSIDER rendezvous with back-up resource on route)

Safety Concerns	
Answer YES if any is true:	
•	Patient is still in a HAZMAT situation, e.g., chemical suicide, gassing, poisoning, drug labs, incidents involving chemicals, chemical leaks, dangerous goods truck accidents;
•	Patient is in an area that is a risk to attending officers, e.g., fire grounds, uncontrolled hot zones, unstable structures, poor access, difficult extrications.

Exceeds Available Resources	
Answer YES if:	
•	3 or more patients on scene requiring transportation

Access & Egress	
Answer YES if any is true:	
•	Patient is trapped;
•	Patient is still waiting to be extricated to a safe location by another agency;
•	Patient is still in a vertical rescue/rescue from height situation;
•	Patient is still in a structural collapse situation;
•	Patient is still in a confined space;
•	Patient is still at risk of crush injury, e.g., any physical trauma where prolonged compression causing ischaemic of the torso, limb(s), or other parts of the body has, or likely to have occurred
