St John WA has updated clinical practice regarding semi-rigid cervical collars and spinal management. Using the NEXUS clinical decision rule and individual factors, our officers will undertake a risk assessment and categorise patients as **Low, Medium** or **High Risk**.







Low risk

Risk factor	Low
No device used	

Medium risk	
NEXUS clinical decision rule	Not cleared
Neurological symptoms	None
Risk factor	Medium
Lanyard, self-splinting and spinal precautions used	

High risk	
NEXUS clinical decision rule	Not cleared
Neurological symptoms	Possible neurological symptoms or is unconscious
Risk factor	High
Semi-rigid collar and spinal immobilisation used
